Based on these findings, the study recommends that educators and institutions should continue to leverage video conferencing applications in EFL education, emphasizing the importance of fostering learner autonomy. Encouraging self-regulated learning strategies and providing guidance tailored to individual needs can empower students to take ownership of their language learning, ultimately enhancing their proficiency and adaptability during unprecedented disruptions such as the Covid-19 pandemic.

Learners enthusiastically engaged in peer discussions, group activities, and collaborative projects. For example, one observation highlighted a virtual breakout session where students engaged in an animated discussion about a current news article, demonstrating their self-directed exploration of the language and culture.

Educators within this digital context actively promoted self-regulated learning strategies, offered personalized guidance, and facilitated critical thinking and problem-solving activities. An observed class session demonstrated an instructor encouraging students to research a topic individually, apply critical thinking skills, and then share their insights with the class, promoting self-regulation and self-directed learning.

Drawing from these insightful findings, the study offers several recommendations for the realm of EFL education during and beyond the challenges posed by the Covid-19 pandemic. It is suggested that educators and educational institutions continue to harness the potential of video conferencing applications as a means of nurturing learner autonomy. The pivotal role of autonomy in language learning is underlined, and the emphasis on encouraging self-regulated learning strategies and personalized guidance tailored to individual learner needs is underscored. These recommendations hold the promise of empowering EFL students to take ownership of their language learning journeys, thereby enhancing their proficiency and adaptability, particularly during unforeseen disruptions such as those wrought by the Covid-19 pandemic.
